Appendix A

Proposed Ecological/Biodiversity Survey Target Areas.

- Hook lane to Tangmere aerodrome to establish the link between our biodiversity corridor and the Tangmere Biodiversity site.
- Hook Lane / Fields an extension to the Hook Lane corridor to take account of the fields opposite Mike Turner's House as Sue indicated that developers were looking at this area.
- Another look at the Cala site to establish current level of activity and ecological interest on the back of last year's brief study.
- The arable field to the east of Nyton Spinney again a site which developers are looking at and about which the council has received significant correspondence from the residents in Barnetts Field particularly the southern side, not previously covered.

The Nyton Spinney might require some additional work on other species as It has been noted that there are dormouse traps around the field. However it is thought that the Spinney is not a particularly attractive Dormouse Habitat but it undoubtedly contains roosting bats.
