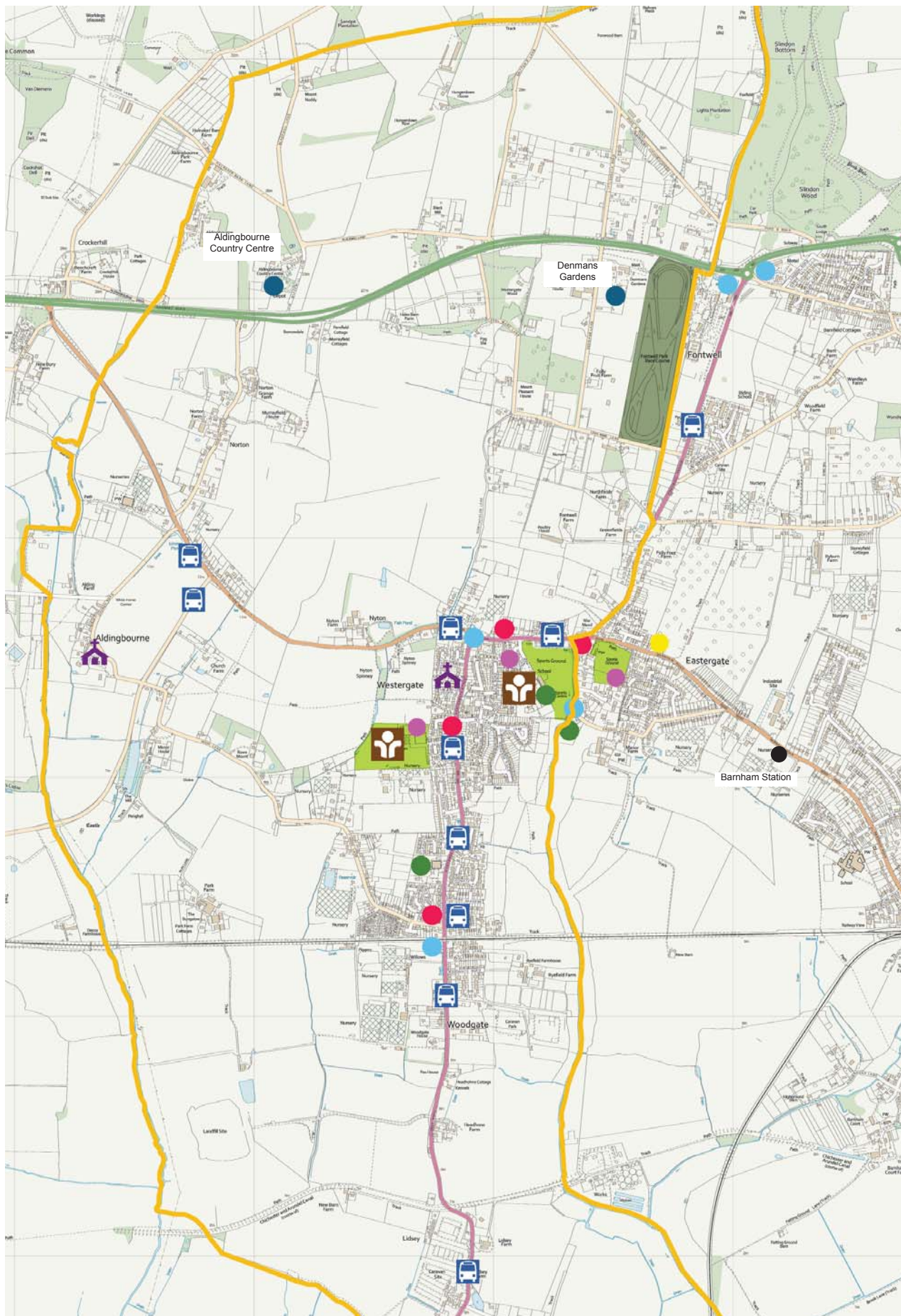


Introduction:

Aldingbourne Parish has a population of approximately 3,900 (2010 census) with over 1,400 households. The demographic indicates that older people (aged 65+) and young families are attracted to the area. Aldingbourne Community Sports Centre and Six Villages Sports Centre provide a wide range of local clubs and societies with access to a good range of indoor and outdoor sports pitches. Within Westergate there is also good provision and distribution of local shops. The results of the parish questionnaire indicates that there is a strong preference for improved community facilities including; allotments, provision for older children and teenagers, improved local bus services and public footpath access to the surrounding countryside.

Key Objectives:

- To promote safe and cohesive communities with access to a wider range of local facilities.
- To promote new play provision within the parish for older children and teenagers.
- To ensure that new communities facilities are inclusive and accessible to all, including older residents.
- Support and promote initiatives that benefit community food production such as allotments and community orchards.
- Ensure that valued green space including school playing fields, outdoor sport and recreational land is protected from development.
