Minutes of the Annual meeting of Aldingbourne Parish Council, held on 1st May 2018 at the Aldingbourne Community Sports Centre

**421. Election of Chairman** - On a proposal by Cllr Foott seconded by Cllr Turner, Cllr Beaton was elected as Chairman

- **422. Election of Vice Chairman** On a proposal by Cllr Foott seconded by Cllr Warden Cllr Turner was elected as Vice Chair.
- **423. Representation on Committees and Working Parties** On a proposal by Cllr Warden seconded by Cllr Turner Committees and Working Party membership was agreed as per the schedule attached to these minutes.
- **424. Declarations of interest-** Cllr Turner made a declarations of personal interest in respect of Allotment matters. Cllr Foott made personal declarations in respect of the item regarding the Planning application AL/123/17/PL Mildmay Hook Lane.
- 425. Urgent Items None
- **426. Public Session** Mrs Hodgson asked about possible reduction in the speed limit for Hook Lane. The Chair stated that as it is designated a quiet lane in the Neighbourhood Plan, then maybe some measures could be considered. Mr Kennedy asked when the lines on the A29 would be repainted. Cllr Whittington responded that these would be on the County Council works programme.
- **427.** Confirmation of Minutes of meeting held on 1st May 2018 On a proposal by Cllr Foott and seconded by Cllr Sturgess the minutes were approved and signed by the Chairman.
- **428. District/County Councillors Report** Cllr Whittington reported that additional resources had been made available for repair of potholes.
- 429.Planning Applications-AL/15/17 Cala Homes, Land west of Westergate Street and AL/123/17 Mildmay, Hook Lane. On a proposal by Cllr Foott and seconded by Cllr Sturgess it was agreed to consider legal advice regarding these applications in closed session.
- 430.AL/20/18 Land at Bridge Cottage noted that this application had been referred by the Planning Committee for determination. As there was no \$106 agreement in place and no capacity for foul water drainage and the access on to and off the site was on a dangerous bend on the A29. It was agreed to object on these grounds with a fuller objection considered once the \$ 106 agreement is negotiated.
- 431. Flooding Aldingbourne School/Hook Lane Noted the correspondence from the School and Paul Cann of ADC. It was agreed that more information was required before the Parish Council could consider any Operation Watershed works. It was therefore agreed that Cllr Warden would arrange to meet with the Headmistress,

Paul Cann and Mr L Ward to obtain background information and report back to the Council.

- **432. GDPR** Noted that the Clerk would prepare the required policies for approval at the June meeting. Agreed that a lap top subject to budget approval could be purchased by the Clerk and that Members would be given new e mail addresses which can be linked to their own email accounts.
- 433. NPPF Consultation Noted the information circulated from CPRE and Cllr Beaton's notes regarding this consultation. Members agreed to feed back their comments to the Clerk so that the consultation could be completed by the Clerk by 12<sup>th</sup> May 2018.
- **434. CLT Steering Group Update** Noted that the meeting on 16<sup>th</sup> April had included a presentation from ADC's Housing Enabler Mr Andy Elder. Next meeting 16<sup>th</sup> May 2018.
